GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Yogesh has filed the present petition *inter alia* praying for regular bail in case FIR No.916 dated 27.11.2018 under Sections 302, 148, 149, 506 & 120-B of IPC and Section 3 of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, registered at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not at all been mentioned in the FIR. He however submits that those who were identified, i.e. Punit as well as Rohit have been granted regular bail by this Court. He further submits that there is no specific allegations against the petitioner. The attribution if at all allegedly, is on Monu and Pardeep, whereas, the petitioner was not at all mentioned in the FIR. In the statement

of PW-1/Sumit @ Meeta, it has been recorded that witness pointed out towards accused Yogesh and Ajay ,whose names he does not know.

In view of the above, this Court deems it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. However, it is made clear that anything observed herein shall not be construed as an expression on merits of the case.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
