Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and for not harassing them on any false criminal complaint.

On 31.01.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. Today, learned State counsel has produced a photocopy of the application addressed to the Station House Officer, Police Station, Sector 11, Chandigarh, which is taken on record, wherein petitioner No.1 has stated that they are living happily and her uncles (respondent Nos.5 and 6) are also happy with this marriage.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.
