The remedy of the petitioner is before the Judge who passed the order dated 2.8.2019 permitting counsel for the plaintiff on a statement made by him that he does not want to proceed with the case further and withdraws the present application. On this statement, the execution application was dismissed as withdrawn.

The petitioner complains that he did not give instructions to Mr. S.N. Aggarwal, Advocate to make the statement. It is not possible for me to make any comment in proceedings under Article 227 of the Constitution of India. If the petitioner is aggrieved by the statement of his counsel, he has remedy in either approaching the Bar Council or to take steps before the same Judge before whom the episode occurred. A direct revision against such an order is not maintainable. It is not for this Court to go into what transpired in the trial Court on 2.8.2019.

In view of this, the petition is dismissed.
