MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to hand over the investigation of the case FIR No.160 dated 27.09.2018, under Sections 353, 186 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib to some independent agency.

The petitioner in person has argued that his prayer is for permission to go abroad. When confronted with the fact that no such prayer has been made by the petitioner in the petition, he is unable to justify the said prayer.

During the course of hearing, it is also not disputed by the petitioner that he has neither associated himself with the investigation nor applied for grant of anticipatory bail. Apart from it, a similar petition bearing No.CRM-M No.40271 of 2019 filed by the petitioner was dismissed as not pressed on 20.09.2019.

In view of the above, no ground is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
