Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 28.01.2020. Photographs of marriage and Marriage Certificate are annexed as Annexure P-3 and P-4. Learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioners have moved a representation to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala (Annexure P-5), but no action has been taken thereon so far.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioners and if required, necessary protection be provided to them.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
