MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0206 dated 24.09.2019, under Sections, 199, 200, 465, 466, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station, City-1 Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the certificate allegedly produced by the petitioner was of his grand-mother, who had expired on 26.07.2006. He submits that the dispute is purely of civil nature and, therefore, petitioner deserves the concession of pre-arrest bail.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any reason to extend the extraordinary concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, who allegedly tried to take the advantage of similarity of the name of his grand-mother Chhinder Kaur with complainant by making an attempt to get the property of complainant transferred in his

name. As per the allegations, a self-declaration was also given by the petitioner, wherein it was mentioned that the property in question belonged to his grand-mother and the same be transferred/mutated in his name as he is the sole legal heir, whereas the actual owner of the property, namely, Chhinder Kaur was alive.

Resultantly, without meaning any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
