The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to direct respondent No.3 to register FIR pertaining to allegations of cheating the petitioner.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments/allegations made in the petition, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to have recourse to all other alternate efficacious remedies for redressal of his grievances including filing an application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. before the Illaqa Magistrate.

In case the petitioner is having any apprehension as regards his life and liberty, it shall be open to the petitioner to move an appropriate application to Senior Superintendent of Police, concerned, which shall be looked into by the Senior Superintend of Police, concerned in accordance with law expeditiously.
