Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.632 dated 07.06.2019 registered under Sections 363, 366, 376, 328 and 506 of IPC at Police Station City, Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Kumar, states that as against 19 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 14 witnesses have already been examined and the left over witnesses, who are merely the official witnesses, are to be examined on 25.03.2020.

In view of advance stage of trial, no case for grant of bail is made out and the present petition is dismissed accordingly.

However, the trial Court is directed to make an endeavour to examine the official witnesses on the adjourned date.
