The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.51 dated 22.04.2018, registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 326, 506, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Goraya District Jalandhar.

As per allegations in the FIR, no overt act has been attributed to the petitioner except to allege that he was also sitting on the motorcycle. Petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender on 13.11.2018. Co-accused of the

petitioner has been acquitted vide order/judgment dated 20.03.2019. Now the petitioner is in custody since 20.10.2019. The offence is triable by the Magistrate.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jagdish Rao could not dispute the aforeasaid factual position. He further submitted that the challan has been presented, but no PW has been examined so far.

Keeping in view the custody of the petitioner and the stage of trial, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing heavy bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
