The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Ranvir Singh has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 16.12.2019 (Annexure P-4), wherein, a request has been made to correct the parents' name of the candidate-Ankit in 10th Class certificate, so that he is able to pursue his 10+2 standard with correct parents name.

Records of the case show that on 03.02.2020, notice of motion was issued and on 15.06.2020 the matter was adjourned for 09.07.2020 i.e. today. However, because of the present COVID situation and a separate notification on the administrative side, the case stands adjourned to

31.08.2020.

The petitioner has filed a CM-5253-CWP-2020 with a prayer *inter alia* to prepone the date of hearing. In the present application, it has been *inter alia* submitted that son of the petitioner is studying in class 10+2 and he has to submit old forms for 10+2 Class as school authorities are demanding the same. The petitioner is unable to submit the certificate with wrong names.

Notice of the application.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is **allowed** and date in the main writ petition is preponed to today i.e. 09.07.2020. With consent of counsel for the parties, main case is taken up on board today itself.

Learned counsel at the outset submits that for same grievance and request as made in the present writ petition i.e. to direct the respondents (especially respondents No.1 & 2/CBSE) to consider and decide the request of the petitioner for correcting the parents' name of candidate-Ankit, he submits that for this prayer, a legal notice of demand for justice had also been served on 16.12.2019.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 16.12.2019 (Annexure P-4) within one month from the date of receipt of copy of the order. Considering the present situation due to

COVID-19, learned State counsel and Registry is directed to send the order through e-mail to the concerned authorities for necessary compliance.

Writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
