This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.137 dated 18.08.2019, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station, Maloya, Chandigarh.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the investigation in the case is pending and the application filed for grant of bail by the husband of the petitioner stands declined. This Court does not find any reason to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. at this stage. Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
