The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.113, dated 21.08.2019, registered under Sections 279, 304A, 420, 473, 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC'), at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. Perusal of the original FIR No.113 dated 21.08.2019 actually discloses the ingredients of the offences under Sections 279, 304-A of the I.P.C. alone, although certain other Sections such as 420, 473, 379 and 411 of the I.P.C. were added subsequently after discovering that the offending vehicle being driven by the Petitioner, was itself a stolen property.

3. Be that as it may, investigation has already been completed and Challan submitted.

4 For the aforesaid reasons, the present Petition is allowed and the Petitioner, namely, Khurshid, is ordered to be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
