MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with the prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus to produce the minor children of the petitioner, namely, Harmandeep Singh aged 17 years and declare the whereabouts of daughter Prabhdeep Kaur aged 20 years.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute this fact that the marriage between the petitioner and respondent No.4 was dissolved on the basis of the mutual consent through a decree dated 10.01.2018 passed by the Family Court, Panchkula. It is clearly mentioned that daughter Prabhdeep Kaur is major, whereas son Harmandeep Singh is 17 years old.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to entertain the petition as the petitioner has alternative remedy to avail. Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
