This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents not to call the petitioner at odd hours at the instance of respondents No.5 and 6 in the matter of fraud committed by private respondents with further prayer to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated 22.01.2020 to Superintendent of Police, Karnal, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P-3, but still no action has been taken.
