The petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn. However, a direction is issued to the the trial Court to make earnest efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously by giving short adjournments, refusing to grant adjournment except for justifiable reason. The accused would also cooperate in prompt completion of trial, by not asking for unnecessary adjournments. The trial be completed preferably within a period of 06 months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
