RAJAN GUPTA, J. (Oral)

Petitioners have prayed for a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing orders dated 4.6.2019 (Annexure P-19) passed by Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Town and Country Planning Department and dated 5.2.2018 (Annexure P-18) passed by respondent No.3 being illegal and arbitrary. Learned counsel submits that pursuant to the aforesaid orders, show cause notice dated 24.1.2020 has been issued.

As assistance of learned State counsel was sought, he has produced a copy of the notice. A perusal thereof shows that the committee inspected the site along with the representative of the licensees regarding execution of internal development works in the colony. The shortcomings have been pointed out in the show cause notice itself. The licensees have been asked to present their case before the authority. Admittedly, the matter is now pending before the said authority on 17.3.2020 before which the licensees are already appearing. As the matter is under consideration by an

authority duly authorized by law, this court is of the considered view that interference in writ jurisdiction is premature.

Needless to observe that the concerned authority would be required to look into all the issues raised by the licensees in this petition. It would be expected of the Director, Town and Country Planning, Haryana to examine the issues afresh without being unduly swayed by the said orders passed on 5.2.2018 and 4.6.2019.

Disposed of.
