The present contempt petition has been filed for non compliance of order dated 17.09.2019, vide which, a direction was issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to decide the representations dated 24.08.2017 and 07.12.2017.

Learned State counsel has placed on record copy of order dated 23.10.2020 passed by the appropriate authority accepting the claim of the petitioner. The necessary consequence of that order shall soon follow.

Taking into account that the seniority of all Group D employees has to be fixed from the year 1996 onwards, it is likely to take some time and they will require atleast 6 months to do the needful.

In view of the same, no further order is required to be passed in the present contempt petition, the same is dismissed as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
