Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.10, dated 06.01.2020 registered under Sections 308, 323, 506, 341, 148, 149 of IPC (Act No.45 of Year 1860) at Police Station Division No.7, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 04.02.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioners were released on interim bail and were directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 04.02.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
