[1] Prayer in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner, who has passed the test under BCA Category with 'O' level computer course from NIELT (DOEACC Society) or HARTRON for adjustment and posting in UHBVN as per merit.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner has served legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 03.06.2019 in respect of the grievances, which are the subject matter of the writ petition, but the same has not been decided, till date and in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 03.06.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 03.06.2019, as expeditiously as possible.
