Petitioners have filed this Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty, who apprehended threats at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 8.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.1 is already married and she has left her matrimonial house. He fairly states that the petitioners have not married and are in live-in-relationship.

This Court has gone through the contents of the petition as well as representation dated 31.01.2020 (Annexure P-3) and it is found that the alleged threat is misconceived. The petition does not inspire any confidence. Resultantly, the same is dismissed.
