Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners received gun shot injuries in the occurrence dated 30.10.2019. Statement of petitioner No.1 was recorded by the police on 6.11.2019, but no FIR was registered as a cross version/ case. In FIR No. 120 dated 31.10.2019 under Sections 307/ 324/ 323/ 341/ 506/ 34 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, Police Station Shri Hargobindpur District Batala, the petitioners are on bail. The representation filed by the petitioners before Director General of Police was referred to respondent No.3 for taking lawful action, but till date no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu,

Sr.DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage, as no order prejudicial to the interest of respondents is being passed.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.3 is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner. In case, any cognizable offence is found to have been committed, in such eventuality, S.H.O. concerned can be asked to act in accordance with law. If no such cognizable offence is found to have been committed, then the petitioner would be informed as per the parameters laid down in **Lalita Kumari v. Govt. of U.P. (2014) 2 SCC (1)**.

Respondent No.3 would be at liberty to assess the situation even by associating the concerned persons in the process of enquiry/ investigation and thereafter, he shall take appropriate action in the matter in accordance with law without being influenced by any observation made herein above.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
