Present revision petition has been filed under Section 15(5) of the East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949 against the orders of eviction, passed by both the Courts below.

At the outset, it is stated by learned Counsel for the petitioner that the premises in question has been vacated and key(s) thereof are handed over to the landlords/respondent(s).

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned Counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 3, 5 & 6.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has further stated that as a full and final settlement qua the mesne profit, an amount of ₹ 2 Lakh by way of demand draft bearing No.066816 dated 17.02.2020, drawn on Punjab National Bank, Chandigarh in favour of respondent No.2 has been handed over and the same is duly accepted by learned Counsel for the respondent(s) with the undertaking to deliver the same to respondent No.2. Copy of the same is taken on record for the purpose of record.

It is jointly stated that now the matter has been amicably settled and no grievance is left against each other. It is also agreed that Civil Suit, pending between the parties for recovery of arrears of rent, shall be withdrawn on the date fixed.

In view of above, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
