Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents and to look into the representation (Annexure P-5).

On 03.02.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, reply by way of affidavit of Joginder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narnaund, District Hisar on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today, wherein it has been stated that during enquiry, it has been found that the whereabouts of the petitioners are not known and they are not found residing at the given address. Statements of private respondent Nos.4 to 8 have been recorded, wherein they expressed no objection to the marriage between the petitioners.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in this petition, which is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
