1. It is seen that after paying a sum of Rs. 5,00,000/-, pursuant to order dated 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 of this Court, no amount whatsoever has been paid by the Petitioner
2. In the circumstances, the Court does not see any reason why any indulgence should be granted to the Petitioner, by interfering in the present writ petition at this stage.
3. It will, however, be open to the Petitioner to work out its remedies before the Debts Recovery Tribunal in accordance with law.
4. The writ petition is dismissed in the above terms.
5. The interim order dated 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 hereby stands vacated.
