Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.223 dated 22.09.2019, registered at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri, under Section 66(B) of the Information Technology Act, 2000 and Sections 120-B and 420 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. The petitioner has nothing to do with the installation of WiFi etc. to facilitate the use of unfair means in on going examination for recruitment of Airman in Air-Force. Moreover, main accused, Sunny Kumar has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 10.02.2020 passed in CRM-M-4935-2020.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the prayer made in the present petition. However, the learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Prem Singh, submits that the prosecution witnesses are

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yet to be examined.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has been in custody since 14.10.2019. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
