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**GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)**

(1) The petitioner *inter alia*, prays for a direction to the respondents to decide his representation by way of passing a speaking order.

(2) At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the impugned order, in fact, the appeal lies to the District Commandant, Punjab Home Guards, Amritsar – respondent No.2.

(3) This Court finds the prayer of the petitioner to be fair and therefore grants permission to the petitioner not to pursue the present writ petition and to file appeal before the respondent No.2 in accordance with law.

(4) Learned counsel then makes a prayer that the appellate authority may be directed to decide the appeal and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, within a time-bound frame. This Court finds that the representation has been submitted on 15.06.2018 (P2) which is stated to have not been decided till now. Therefore let the competent authority decide the appeal now to be submitted by the petitioner within 2 weeks from today and this Court has no doubt that the respondents would decide the same within a reasonable time. However, the same be decided maximum within 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

(5) Ordered accordingly.
