1. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to consider the candidature of the petitioner for the post of Shift Attendant in response to advertisement No.3/2016 (Annexure P/1) in the light of SC certificate Annexure P/2.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioner has served legal notice Annexure P/4 dated 20.04.2019 in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the writ petition but the claim made therein has not been decided till date and in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the same in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent

No.2 and waives service and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide legal notice Annexure P/4 dated 20.04.2019, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
