Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondents not to call the petitioner in Police Station Machhiwara, Khanna or in the office of DSP, Khanna and Crime against Women & Children, Sangrur at the behest of his wife Navjot Kaur, without giving him advance notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has no grouse against the Police Stations Machhiwara or Khanna and confines his prayer qua the District Sangrur to which the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 06.12.2019 (Annexure P-3).

Lest it may prejudice the interest of the parties in any manner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police to look into the contents of representation dated 06.12.2019 (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.
