In compliance of order dated 22.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced receipt of ₹20,000/-. The same is taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.128 dated 25.03.2016, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 427, 506, 325 IPC, at Police Station Rajendra Park, Gurugram, District Gurugram (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 20.08.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 04.09.2019 to get their

statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurugram, has submitted her report vide letter bearing No.627 dated 06.11.2019, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurugram, vide Endst. No.2695/C.29 dated 13.11.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntarily and without any pressure.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.128 dated 25.03.2016, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 427, 506, 325 IPC, at Police Station Rajendra Park, Gurugram, District Gurugram (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the quarters concerned.
