This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.0093 dated
30.7.2019 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467,
468,471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Shambhu District Patiala.

Allegations against the petitioners are that they
identified the vendee Surinder Singh, who had purchased the
land of deceased Mann Kaur from Som Kaur, who had
allegedly impersonated Mann Kaur. Som Kaur has already
surrendered.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the
petitioners are neither privy to any transaction, nor
impersonated Mann Kaur. They have identified the correct

person Surinder Singh and there is no antecedent behaviour of the petitioners in respect of any forgery committed in the present case. Petitioners are in custody since 31.12.2019. Even otherwise a compromise has been effected between the complainant Paramjit Singh on the one hand and Surinder Singh, Karamjit Singh and Gurwinder Singh on the other hand.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Malwinder Singh, submitted that the allegations against the petitioners are of identifying the purchaser Surinder Singh.

The complicity of the petitioners would be debatable.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, it would be just and appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioners.

In view of above, this petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
