In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioners is for promoting them as Head Masters w.e.f. the date the person junior to them was promoted.

Learned counsel for the respondents argues that according to the State, no person, who was junior to the petitioners has been promoted in preference to the petitioners, which will cause prejudice to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in order to seek instructions from the petitioners, she tried to contact the petitioners but failed and therefore, she does not have any instruction at this stage to pursue the matter.

Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution, at this stage, with liberty to the petitioners to revive the same, in case any of the grievances raised by the petitioners in the present writ petition still survives.
