The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.83, dated 11.07.2019, registered under Sections 302, 201, 120-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Alewa, District Jind.

2. The Petitioner was arrested on 15.07.2019.
3. Admittedly, no one was named in the FIR.
4. Petitioner has been implicated purely on the strength of his own Disclosure Statements, which are *per se* inadmissible in evidence.
5. Ld. Counsel for the State has been unable to show any material whatsoever collected during investigation, which would stand the test of admissibility.

6. Further detention of the Petitioner, in the circumstances, for an indefinite period, is not justified. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
