RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (Oral)

Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.1086 dated 11.09.2019, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later), at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner is in custody since 28.09.2019. No recovery has to be effected from him. Co-accused of petitioners namely Sagar @ Chhagri and Nikhil have already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 13.01.2020 in CRM-M-52793 and 54315 of 2019 respectively. Conclusion of trial may take a sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any more in jail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed

the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, treating the case of petitioner on the same parity as that of his above co-accused, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner Sandeep Kumar is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
