Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 03.2.2020 in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, AAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioners have placed on record only the copies of

Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as proof of their age.

Four photographs on one sheet as Annexure P-4 and a copy of certificate as Annexure P-3 regarding performance of marriage, have also been placed on record.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 03.2.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
