This 2nd petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.142 dated 05.11.2015, under Sections 307, 323 read with Section 34 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station, Division No.3 Jalandhar. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of police, in the above FIR.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the petitioner had himself appeared before the Court on 24.10.2019 and thereafter, he never appeared before the trial Court. On 14.11.2019, the trial Court proceeded to cancel the bail of the petitioner and forfeited the bail bonds. On subsequent dates also, petitioner absented from the trial proceedings.

In view of the above, the petition for grant of pre-arrest bail is not maintainable in view of the decision dated 04.04.2019 delivered by this

Court in CRM-M No.15464 of 2019 (Balwant Singh @ Banta Versus State of Punjab). Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
