Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty, who apprehended threats at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Learned State counsel has produced the statements of respondent Nos.4 to 6 (parents and maternal uncle of petitioner No.1 respectively). Copy thereof have been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. In the statements of respondent Nos.4 to 6, it is mentioned that they have no objection to the alleged marriage performed by the petitioners.

In view of the statements of respondent Nos.4 to 6, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition.

The petition is dismissed as not pressed.
