This is an appeal that has been filed against the acquittal of the accused-respondent Nos. 2 to 5 in an FIR which was registered under Section 363, 366-A, 376 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Gidderbaha on the allegations that the daughter of the complainant-Rajinder Kumar had been forcibly taken away by the accused-respondent Nos. 2 to 5 . The matter was investigated and charges were framed. The trial Court based on the evidence came to hold that the prosecution was unsuccessful in proving its case. Aggrieved against the said order, the present appeal has been filed.

Since no one was putting in appearance on behalf of the appellant, notices were issued to the appellant as well as to his representing counsel.

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As per the office report, both the appellant and his counsel are duly served, however, despite service no one has put in appearance to address arguments.

Consequently, the appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution.
