The present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a direction to the respondents to give appointment to the son-petitioner of late Shri Raj Pal Singh Ex-multipurpose Health Worker (male) as per instructions of the Government Annexure P-1.

The brief facts of the case are that father of the petitioner had expired on 04.07.1982 when he was working as Ex-multipurpose Health Worker (male) in the pay scale of Rs.400/- to 600/- per month. Petitioner was minor and he became eligible for government service on 01.01.1992 after attaining the age of 17 years. Thereafter, he gave his application forms and after doing his formalities of working proof of income, an ex-gratia policy dated 08.05.1995 and 31.08.1995 came into effect and after the said policy, an ex-gratia appointment could be given of one pay scale lower to the dependent of the deceased employees.

Keeping in view of this policy, petitioner initially refused to apply

for the Class-IV post and thereafter he gave his consent for the said post on

17.07.1997 in the office of respondent No.3 and thereafter, the petitioner had joined in the office of Civil Surgeon, Faridabad on 04.02.1998.

Since the petitioner has already joined and is working the office of Civil Surgeon, Faridabad, in the post of Class-IV after giving his consent, no further direction are required to be given the present writ petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of .
