Petitioner, in this writ petition, seeks quashing of the action of the authorities in changing the site/place of the Gauge Meter and seeks benefit to the petitioner by treating the meter to be fixed at the original place and further refund of the excess amount allegedly received by the department.

The petitioner, had taken a Gharat on lease from the authorities for one year i.e., 1997-98. It is claimed that excess amount was being charged due to change in site of the gauge meter as it wrongly reflected extra consumption. The respondents, in their reply filed in this case, have taken a specific stand that the site of the gauge meter has not been changed and it remains at the same place and site, as it was at the time of auction.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondent-State, that disputed questions of fact are involved in this writ petition.

None was appearing on behalf of the petitioner and notice was issued to him.

As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner by registered post, has been received back with the report of refusal.

It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing this writ petition any longer.

Writ petition is accordingly dismissed in default.
