RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

Through this petition the order dated 3.8.2018 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.), Talwandi Sabo has been assailed by the judgment debtors (JDs).

The properties of the JDs were ordered to be attached for a period of six months from the date of attachment under Order 21 Rule 32 CPC. The interim injunction by the trial Court was of six months and will expire in February 2020. The trial Court has examined the allegations of violation of the decree by the JDs, after a full fledged trial and has found from the evidence the existing criminal cases filed by the decree holder against the JDs for violation of the mandatory injunction in the decree.

I find no error in exercise of discretion by the trial Court in the application and find no ground to interfere with the well reasoned order dated 3.8.2018 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.), Talwandi Sabo.

The petition is dismissed.
