The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for registering the FIR against respondent No.4 for cheating and committing fraud with the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has been duped of an amount of ₹ 7.6 lakhs by respondent No.4 on the pretext of sending the petitioner abroad. It has been submitted that a substantial amount out of said amount of ₹ 7.6 lakhs was transferred to the account of respondent No.4 through bank transactions. Learned counsel has submitted that although he had made a representation to the police on 29.1.2019 (Annexure P-3) but the same has not been considered so far.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of representation dated 29.1.2019 (Annexure P-3), if not already decided, in accordance with law at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-3 be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
