This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 4 to present the challan in the cross case DDR No.13 dated 14.08.2018 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 148, 323, 324 and 452 IPC read with Section 149 IPC registered at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda in FIR No.58 dated 13.08.2018 under Sections 148, 307, 323 and 452 IPC read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act (Section 34 IPC and Section 3 (2) (v) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 are added later on and Sections 148, 452 and 149 IPC are deleted, vide Diary No.13 dated 11.10.2018) registered at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for petitioners contended that petitioners

have already made representation dated 17.04.2019 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P-4, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Arun Beniwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to look into and decide representation dated 17.04.2019 (Annexure P-4) as expeditiously as possible and that too in accordance with law.
