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**RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (Oral)**

Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.1086 dated 11.09.2019, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel contends that no specific role has been attributed to petitioner. Co-accused of petitioner namely Sagar @ Chhagri and Nikhil have been granted regular bail by this Court vide orders dated 13.01.2020, in CRM-M-52793 and 54315-2019. Petitioner is in custody since 30.09.2019. Conclusion of trial may take a sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any more in jail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, treating the case of the petitioner on parity as that of his above-named accused, instant petition stands allowed. Consequently, petitioner Varun alias Bunty is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
