Petitioner-Teja Singh has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.192 dated 21.7.2017 under Sections 379, 427, 434, 447 and 511 IPC, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has *inter alia* argued that in the present case the allegation against the petitioner was that in pursuance of directions issued by the Court, the petitioner alongwith revenue officers came to the fields and uprooted the Burjis and cut the barbed wires and therefore, the present FIR was registered. He has further submitted that a false case has been registered against the petitioner because he never

uprooted the Burjis and thereafter application was filed before the Civil Court in which a finding has come that their petition has not succeeded and therefore, the contempt application has been dismissed vide Annexure P-3 and therefore he prays for grant of anticipatory bail in the present case.

Notice of the petition was issued to the State on 10.2.2020.

Learned State counsel has put in appearance and on instructions from the investigating officer states that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is fully cooperating in the investigation process and he is not required further for custodial interrogation.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
