This application has been filed for recalling order dated 4.6.2020, whereby the State was burdened with costs of Rs.20,000/-.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Order dated 4.6.2020 regarding imposition of costs of Rs.20,000/- on the State is hereby recalled.

The prayer in this writ petition is for directions to the respondents to terminate the unwanted pregnancy of the minor daughter of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the interregnum, the pregnancy has been terminated under orders of this Court. Thus, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous. However, as the daughter of the petitioner had been kidnapped once again by the accused,

directed that she be housed in a Nari Niketan, during the pendency of the writ petition. This order was passed after she was produced in the Court by the police. Now, it has been more than two months since she was sent to the Nari Niketan and the petitioner wants the custody of her daughter to be restored to her.

The State of Haryana has no objection in case the custody of the daughter of the petitioner is restored to her.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the State of Haryana to restore the custody of the daughter of the petitioner to her within seven days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
