Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he be allowed to withdraw the instant petition insofar as petitioner No.1 is concerned. Permitted to do so. Present petition qua petitioner No.1 is dismissed as withdrawn.

Ashu Singh (Petitioner No.2), before this Court, claims himself to be major. He has pleaded that he has married petitioner No.1-Deepika against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5 and seeks protection to his life and liberty. He apprehends danger from respondents No.4 and 5. He has placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-4 and P-3, respectively evidencing their marriage. Representation Annexure P-5 has already been made to Superintendent of Police, Panipat.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation Annexure P-5 and grant protection to petitioner No.2, if any threat to his life and liberty is

perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioner No.2 from legal action for violation of law if any committed by the petitioners.
