By this petition, the petitioner challenges the orders passed by the learned trial court on 29.08.2019, by which his evidence (he being the plaintiff), was closed; and the order passed thereafter on 20.01.2020, by which his application seeking recalling of that order, was dismissed.

Notice of motion having been issued in this petition, learned counsel had put in an appearance on the last date of hearing and it had been pointed out that in fact that even the evidence of the respondent-defendant had also been closed by the order of the trial court, dated 06.01.2020.

Today, he submits that in view of that position, the respondent does not oppose the present petition, provided the petitioner allows the respondent-defendant also to lead evidence thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would not oppose that.

That being so, this petition is allowed, with both the impugned orders

set aside.

The petitioner shall be granted one opportunity to get himself cross-examined, after which the defendant will be given two opportunities to conclude his evidence, by examining any other witnesses that he wishes to.
