It has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are sister and brother. Respondents No. 4 and 5 are brothers and respondents No. 6 and 7 are sister-in-law of the petitioner(s). Respondents No. 4 to 7 have been disinherited by the parents and after their death, they are threatening to take possession of the property left by them.

It has also been stated that on 26.01.2020, private respondents had inflicted injuries on the person of the petitioners and they are apprehending threat and danger at their instance. Counsel further submits that in this regard, a representation dated 01.02.2020 (Annexure P-11) has already been submitted to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the grievance of the petitioners, in accordance with law.
