Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 193 dated 20.11.2019 registered under Sections 379-B, 325, 323 and 34 IPC, at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Moreover, the co-accused have already been granted the concession of bail.

Heard.

The injuries attributed to the petitioner are on head and fracture on the arm of Paramjit Singh, besides he has also snatched away the gold chain of the victim.

After perusal of the FIR and judgment dated 15.01.2020 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, no ground is made to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Present petition is dismissed accordingly.
