The petitioner was already on bail but could not appear before the Ld. Trial Court on a solitary date i.e. 20.04.2019 as he was already in custody in connection with some other case on that date. As such, his bail bonds were cancelled and warrants of arrest were ordered to be issued against him.

In the opinion of this Court, the grounds justifying the petitioner's absence on the relevant date are tenable. It is not a case where his absence was willful or for reasons beyond his control.

In the circumstances, the impugned order dated 08.01.2020 (Annexure P-1) is set aside and the petitioner is ordered to be released on a fresh bail to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court.
